
# Message from the scribes pen

### Tim Moore.... District Governor 9820 Is your club Ready?

Tim spoke about How to attract new members and How to retain existing members and asked the question is your club Ready?

Consider where you meet? Are you ready for a new member? Make them welcome! Seen as an older club we need to look at a family of Rotary, maybe with a kid's corner to encourage younger members.

Tim also spoke of a new nationwide PR program to get the Rotary message out there. He gave examples of Casey Club, and how they have quick meetings and mini projects, highlighting the Importance of just asking friends to just come along and try. Tim stressed the benefits to your club of a strong group of Friends of Rotary.

Tim gave us an overview of Rotary and the amazing effort in eradicating Polio by 2018. How the Gates Foundation is matching every rotary \$1 with \$2. Tim explained how The Foundation and Centurion, Erey and Paul Harris Society works and how some people donate and receive the award for their support. Rotary Foundation money stays in Australia and every \$100 donated to Rotary International in 3 years we receive \$50 directly back to the district. 100% tax deduction.
