17th September 2013


### Rotarians,

### Organo Gold Coffee -

A presentation to the club members by Organo Gold. This brand of coffee was introduced as a potential fund raising idea for our club. The system is based on internet ordering and no invoicing, collections or deliveries. Cost of annual fee of \$49.95 would set the club as a wholesaler. Profits appear in a Ewallet and earn \$10 per sale of coffee. The market they are aiming at is instant coffee drinkers and the drink contains Ganoderma .

Some questions on the coffee, whether the coffee was benefiting a community such as fair trade?. The coffee was Arabica bean and not sourced from any particular country. Bill felt that the coffee would not appeal to many as the pod systems are so popular
