Heather - spoke of the benefits of our members attending the Bendigo conference and requested the board to consider facilitating the attendance our members by paying the conference fee.

Kim -wished Mark all the best on participating in the ride to conquer cancer at the weekend. Participants raised \$2,500 and ride 200kms ride in 2 days. The ride will spend the night at Hastings so an added local flavour to the event.
