Around the Table:

Treasurer (Acting Secretary) Faye- Emu Plains market starts on 19th October,

Heather- advised that Paul Leeson has requested a receipt for four meals.

Youth Jeff—Jeff spoke about \$25,000 grant to support the community development work Linking school and early years. A project worker has been appointed for 2 years through Good Shepherd and the dept of human service who also provided money via a grant of \$100,000 As the money we provided came through the Benalong foundation it is important the we speak to the appointed project worker to cover the reporting requirements of the grant. Jeff is in contact with the person

Eric- spoke about an acquaintance who works as a school nurse, A person who deals with very different issues to what would

have been a bandage and sticky plaster job to now dealing with life issues . The person also works as a volunteer with City of Melbourne working with homeless. Eric felt it would be interesting to have her along to speak.

Port of Hastings Dinner – A sheet was circulated for attendance on the 30^{th} October note there will be no meeting on the 28^{th} October. Cost of the dinner will be \$38.00per head. The club will book tables, please pay next meeting.

Faye-showed to meeting 2 flyers developed to promote the Hastings Market. All at the meeting like the designs.

Doug- handed over a letter from the Nepean Junior Football, thanking for our work and a cheque for \$3,000

Heather - asked for clarification on the information regarding the resignation of Peter Cole.

Kim - explained that Peter had indicated that we (the Club) didn't meet his expectations.

Jeff- explained that the board meeting had been an uncomfortable experience and that Peter had been insistent that we (the Club) had not taken the opportunity to return funds back into the community. That monies raised at the golf day had been given so that money was supporting the local community. Money currently in trust is \$15,000 and \$45,000 in general accounts.

Discussion continued and questions raised about whether Peter's decision was irrevocable as he was a valued member. Jeff felt we could always place more funds into the "play on "work.

Golf Day - was very much Peter's work last year and it was decided that we could not start this project at such a late stage. It was decided that we would look at running a golf day next year and letters would be sent out to last year's sponsors and Alan Harwood from Mornington Rotary advising that we would be looking at running the Golf day in 2015.

Linda- spoke about the need to update our incorporation documents and this was a project that Peter as Secretary was undertaking. Linda will contact the Denis from Casey club for their draft documentation and do some general research. Linda also suggested that the club was able to do some brain storming to look at local projects. That it was important to increase the profile of our club in the local area. Successful projects such as the BBQ shelter on the foreshore and other ideas from past experiences that will help the community and also keep our profile out there so we can attract new members. Eric spoke about the Christmas tree project and other professional events that could service the community and club well.

Kim - closed the meeting with the following, firstly \$40.00 raised in the Red Cross bake off and we will send \$100.00 to them. Rotary Health Hat night on 14th October so all wear a hat...

Doug- Leah from the Hastings Police we need to have her come along to pick up the \$670.00
