**Mandy** - advised that MPSC will be in contact regarding our adoption of a hot spot for Graffiti. Roy introduced our speakers on the subject of Westernport Christmas Giving Program

One of the major donations of toys comes from the Peninsula toy run. History is that in 1996 they gave out 20 hampers in 2013 they distributed 371 toys to children 0-12 years. They are a package of toys that are wrapped so they can't be seen by the children. They are a group of 68 volunteers and a committee of 10 who work independently but with Westernport community support, Food for all and the Salvation Army and cover this side of the peninsula. Total of 981 volunteer hours and 400 hampers. Clients of Westernport community support fill out applications in November and they are crossed checked. Funding comes from BHP and 30 other organisations no funds from philanthropic trusts. Hampers are given to 200 families and 200 singles and aged.
