Hat Day hits a high

The hype surrounding <u>Hat Day</u> hit a high when Channel Seven hosted two of their celebrity ambassadors on the *Morning Show* last month. Matt Lee, the Australian dancer and actor, former judge on Australia's *So You Think You Can Dance* and winner of the 2011 Helpmann Award for Best Male Actor in a Musical (*Mary Poppins*), and Elle Dawe, Australian actor most famous for her role in the TV Show *Housos*, have publicly supported the mission of Hat Day to shine a light on mental illness in Australia. In two separate interviews, they told Channel Seven audiences that Hat Day is a fun and positive way for people to get involved and show their support for friends, colleagues, family members and others in the community who may be affected by depression, anxiety, schizophrenia, anorexia and other mental illnesses.

Hat Day is an initiative of <u>Australian Rotary Health</u> held on October 11 during National Mental Health Week. 100 per cent of proceeds go to funding mental health research projects through the provision of Research Grants. Rotary clubs around Australia have registered a range of events to "hat up" and demonstrate their support for Hat Day. They include hat-themed club meetings, trivia nights, dinners, flash mobs, parties and other special events.

"Our DG dance for Hat Day is progressing well," said Australian Rotary Health District 9630 Representative Russ Higginbotham

Hat Day Corporate Manager Terry Davies is encouraging all Rotarians and supporters to flick the switch on Mental Health and shine the light on Australian Rotary Health's Hat Day for 2013

"Don't forget your work colleagues, organise a Hat Day at your workplace and be a trail blazer for mental health research," Terry said.
